
**ORDER DIRECTING AND COMPELLING DISCLSURE OF SETTLEMENT, ACCOUNTING AND TURNOVER OF SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS**

CAME ON for hearing the Trustee’s Motion Seeking Order Compelling and Directing Debtor and Attorneys to Disclose Settlement, the whereabouts of the settlement proceeds, for Accounting and Turnover and after hearing the evidence and the argument of counsel finds that such Motions should be GRANTED. The Court finds that any settlement and settlement proceeds paid as a result of settlement of Debtor’s lawsuit against Dr. Pankaj Shah are non-exempt property of the estate and Mark Cantu is a fiduciary regarding them.

Bill Abernethy and the Donnell, Abernethy Law Firm; Kathy Julia and the Driscoll & Driscoll Law Firm; as well as Mark Cantu and the Law Offices of Mark Cantu are ORDERED, DIRECTED AND COMPELLED to immediately disclose to the Trustee all of the specifics of the settlement and provide him with true copies of all documents concerning it. Kathy Julia and the Driscoll & Driscoll Law Firm; as well as Mark Cantu and the Law Offices of Mark Cantu are ORDERED, DIRECTED AND COMPELLED to immediately disclose the whereabouts of the settlement proceeds to the Trustee. Kathy Julia and the Driscoll & Driscoll Law Firm; as well as Mark Cantu and the Law Offices of Mark Cantu are ORDERED, DIRECTED AND COMPELLED to immediately account for and immediately turnover to the Trustee all settlement proceeds. The term “immediately” as used in this Order, means as quickly as possible, but no later than three (3) days from the date of this Order. The term “accounting” as used in this Order means a full accounting of the settlement proceeds, any amounts paid therefrom, copies of all distribution documents or checks, disclosure of full information on the present whereabouts of any and all proceeds. The term “turnover” as used in this Order means actual physical deliver to the Trustee of any and all proceeds. *Settlement will remain CONFIDENTIAL in the hands OF the Trustee, subject to further order OF this court.*

IT IS SO ORDERED.
