- 2. The Creditor Trustee shall be awarded post-judgment interest at the statutory rate from the date this Judgment is entered until paid in full pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961.

- 3. Final Judgment is entered against the Defendant and in favor of the Creditor Trustee on Count IV of the Complaint. Accordingly, any and all claims of the Defendant against the Debtors or the Creditor Trust, whether asserted in a proof of claim or scheduled on the Debtors' schedules of assets and liabilities are disallowed pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502(d).
 - 4. Count II, pled in the alternative to Count I, is hereby dismissed as moot.
